We can also invite them over to a campfire, to go golfing, or to a softball game. These are just a few ways to build relationships, but there are plenty of ways to do that. As I am challenged to do that, I want to remind others to build relationships too.

The month of June has just started, so take advantage of some of the outside time to engage others – I know plenty of you like to hike or sit at the beach at Devil's Lake. See, Jesus commanded us to "make disciples". I wish it were easy, but it takes time and effort. It takes effort to build relationships. It takes time for people to respond to God's love and Good News. It takes time to teach people about what we see in the Scriptures. And, it takes time to become a part of a church.

New Life Community A.C. Church Board Meeting Minutes May 2018

Trustees – the trustees are working on a few projects. First, they have accepted a bid to remodel the bathrooms. A new floor will be put down, along with exchanging out the toilets, stalls, and counters. One bathroom will be done at time. They are also working with Top Hat to begin putting up Solar Panels outside on the roof. That will begin soon.

Day Care – the Day Care has approved covering the expense of fixing the venting to one of their rooms. Right now room 4 runs off a separate heater and A/C unit. After rerouting, it will run of the furnace and A/C unit that heats and cools all the other Day Care rooms.

Pastor Jed – He will be going to NC to train the Summer Team with other teams and trainers, spending the week at Camp Dixie. After he returns, he will be going to Family Camp in CA and teaching at the end of June. He will also be leading Jr. Camp at Expeditions from July 15-20th.

Pastor Jesse – The Natural Church Development (NCD) process continues to move forward. Kim Wegner is doing a great job leading that discussion in how we can develop an Effective Structure that helps New Life to fulfill its mission. We are currently working through how the Mission is completed at New Life, how the ministries can be coordinated. This is hoped to be finished by the end of the summer and then introduced to committees.
