# Making the Most out of a Tough Situation Daniel 1:1-21 3/22/2020

#### What do we do in the middle of a CRISIS?

#### 1. Understand that bad circumstances, doesn't mean bad outcome.

Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

#### 2. Continually turn to God.

Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God.

#### 3. Understand where my growth and direction comes from.

Psalm 111:10 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding. To him belongs eternal praise.

## 4. Don't let circumstances dictate your attitude.

Jeremiah 29:7 Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper. ... 10 This is what the Lord says: "When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will come to you and fulfill my gracious promise to bring you back to this place. 11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

### 5. God's blessing doesn't mean that He will bring me out of the tough place.

James 1:2 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, 3 because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. 4 Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
