

BIBLE IN A YEAR

We welcome you to join us as we make our way through the Bible this year. You will need to read through Leviticus 4 by January 31st.



Sun 1/7 ~ through Genesis 25 Sun 1/14 ~ through Genesis 43 Sun 1/21~ through Exodus 15 Sun 1/28 ~ through Exodus 36 Sun 1/31 ~ through Leviticus 4 Have you ever got up in the middle of the night and didn't turn on the light so that you won't bother anyone else? If you're like me, you put your arms out in front of you to try to detect anything that you might stumble over and then quietly make your way out of the room. We have some GFCI outlets in our home that have a tiny green light on them, and once I'm out of our bedroom that little green light seems to illuminate the entire hallway, so I can put my arms down. It's quite a relief to not have to worry about stubbing my toe or hitting my head on the door.

Isaiah predicts the coming of a great light into the midst of utter darkness. He speaks figuratively here as He describes a world of sinful people as "the people who walk in darkness" and the coming Messiah as the "great light." We don't think of ourselves as walking in darkness, especially when we're outside on a sunny day. But when we curse that person who cut us off in traffic, ignore a person in need, write down 40 hours of work when we only did 39, or take that drink or drug we said we'd never take again, we are walking in darkness, and there's no amount of good we can do to make up for it. We need someone to save us. We need the light of forgiveness and grace to bring us out of the darkness of our guilt and shame because of our

It's interesting that the first people God chooses to tell about the birth of His Son, are some shepherds, and He tells them in the middle of the night. Here's what Luke 2:8-9 says: "In the same region there were some shepherds staying out in the fields and keeping watch over their flock by night. And an angel of the Lord suddenly stood be-

fore them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them; and they were terribly frightened." I've been told that most (not all) shepherds were not the most respectable citizens. I wonder what they were doing' when the angel with the glory of the Lord (presumably a very bright intense light) shining around him suddenly stood in their midst. Were they getting drunk? Were they gambling and cheating one another out of money? Whatever they were doing, they were very afraid. So afraid that they trembled with fear of being struck dead, because God saw whatever they were doing, and they were ashamed.

But God doesn't strike them dead...in fact He does the very opposite. He shows them grace and tells them about the birth of His Son. Then He sends them to Bethlehem to prove that what He says is true. After they had seen Jesus and were returning to their flock, they were glorifying and praising God for all they had seen and heard. This is what happens to us when we're told about Jesus. At first we doubt if God would want anything to do with us other than to smite us for our sins, but when we hear about Jesus from a friend or read about him in the Bible we understand He's not going to strike us down, but rather, He has taken our sins and suffered for us so we could be forgiven. Then our fears are turned to gladness, and we rejoice like the shepherds over how gracious God has been to us. After Jesus birth, you no longer need to walk in the darkness of your sin and shame, because we now have Jesus, the light of the world, who wants to come into your heart and fill you with the light of His love and mercy and grace.
