Shining the LIGHT of Jesus

This week New Life hosted Vacation Bible School (VBS) at the church. It was a great week as all the attendees learned that Jesus is the light of the world (John 8:12). Each day of VBS we were challenged not only to accept Jesus as our light, but to also shine Jesus' light. We learned that we can shine Jesus' light when people are sad, by being with them and comforting them. We learned that we can shine Jesus' light when we have blessings too, by pointing to and thanking God for them. There was no doubt that all the children who attended were not only encouraged to trust in Jesus as their light, but to also share the light of Jesus with others.

By the end of the week, New Life had a total 35 plus children who attended. We also had numerous volunteers too – some helped prepare for VBS and others during the week. Our count of volunteers was at least 25 people who helped prepare and carry out the service of teaching, helping, leading, and caring for the children who came. There is no doubt we could not have been successful without the help of these volunteers. Also, at the end of the week, we hosted a BIG picnic for parents and family members too. There was a total of at least 65 people at the picnic. It was great for the parents and other family members to see and hear what their children learned this week, in the setting they learned it. Not only that, but it was great to meet the parents and other people that did not come to VBS.

Now, why am I sharing this information? I want everyone to know

the significance not only of VBS, but also of our opportunity to impact people. Some of the people and children came this week because they were invited. Some people came because they were friends or neighbors. Some people came because they were family members. I want us to realize that all around are people who need to see, hear, and feel the Love of God through people like us. It does not matter if you go to New Life or not, what matters is if you are a follower of Jesus. If you are a follower of Jesus, then you, like me, have been given a command from Jesus to "love one another". That means not only showing care and compassion, but also letting them know about the person who loves them the most – Jesus.

Since our season has changed to summer, there are many opportunities to see or be with neighbors, friends and family. I want to challenge all of us, myself included, to look for opportunities to share the Light of Jesus. By sharing the light, this means caring for people, it means encouraging people, it means giving thanks to God in front of people, and it means letting people know about the love of Jesus. I hope that as you see an opportunity, you will ask for courage from God to use it share your light (Matthew 5:16). While our VBS was specifically for people aged 3-11, remember that God wants EVERYONE to know Him (1 Peter 3:9). So, be ready for the opportunities God provides you to SHARE HIS LIGHT with those around you.


