Thank you does not begin to say what I want to, but I am very grateful you see this need, and stay focused on helping this family.

#### (Epilogue)

I dropped off the newest batch of diapers at Pathway House. Our church and friends have donated 18 cases of diapers to the shelter over the last month (as well as eight crocheted and knitted hats) and we are meeting their needs.

What I think is very neat is, families of church members have also put in

toward the diaper donating. So people are hearing us share about a need, and being part of the solution. It is special.
