Praying that you and I live life as a Disciple of Jesus

When we began our sermon series in September, focusing on "Living a life as a disciple of Jesus", we as leaders at New Life, began being challenged and hope to have been challenging the people of New Life to consider how we are doing in living our mission of being disciples of Jesus who make disciples. In the weeks since the series has started, we have been challenged with being hospitable with others in our church, in our homes and in our lives. We were given this challenge from Romans 12:13 "Practice hospitality."

The 2nd message was based upon Acts 2:37-47. This passage challenges us to be involved in a group of believers, and not just involved but a member too. For when we join and we make a commitment to the group and to help it grow, this leads to our own personal growth too.

The 3rd message, last weeks, challenged us to serve and be involved in ministry to show God's love and care to others. When we see a need, then we can share our gifts and use our spiritual gifts to serve others like Jesus did. This message was based on 1 Corinthians 12:1-13.

This coming Sunday, October 1st, will be a baptism Sunday. The two sacraments we practice at New Life - baptism and the Lord's supper - will be practiced this coming Sunday. There will be four people being baptized and as a church, we will also participate in taking Communion together. The reason we do both of these is that this is something that Jesus did (both baptism and the Lord's supper), and encourages us to do. And not only does He encourage us to do it, He also wants us to do within the context of our local church. I hope you come and celebrate the baptisms and have Communion with us too.

Now, back to the series. Why are we doing this series? Because we, as leaders want to grow, we want our church people to grow, our church to grow, and the Kingdom of God to grow too. See, when we grow, we get to experience more and more blessings as believers. The same is true of other believers. So as believers in New Life grow, they too experience more blessings in their walk with Jesus. Likewise, as New Life grows, our church can be more involved in helping others grow, serve, love and shine the light of Jesus. Lastly, just as Jesus tells us to "make disciples" in Matthew 28:19, we too should put His instruction into practice. Therefore, as we share about Jesus, we are hoping and praying that God's Kingdom grows.

Now, I share this because I want you the reader to think about how you are growing spiritually. I know not all of you attend New Life, but I hope you attend a church somewhere. Gathering with other believers is a requirement for growth. It encourages us, gives us a place to serve, opportunities to worship, and helps us grow. It allows us to invest spiritually in others, and gives us a place for us to be a FAMILY of God. So, when we go to church, especially at New Life, we are challenging ourselves to grow and helping other grow too. So as you grow, look for opportunities to help others grow spiritually too. As this is where "making disciples" comes into play. It is not just bringing people to faith, but also includes building them up in the Lord. So, please pray for our spiritual growth at New Life. Ask that God grow us individually, as a church, and that He use us as His people to build His Kingdom. Now, let's look forward to what God does as we faithfully follow Him.
