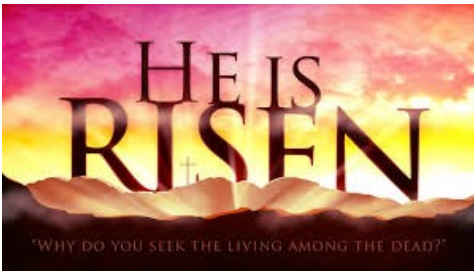

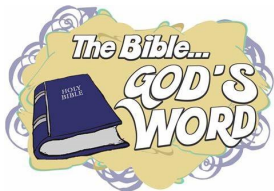
Matthew 28:5-6

Living each day as a victorious follower of Jesus

This past Sunday was Easter Sunday - or using another phrase, Resurrection Sunday. This is the day that we recognize as the day that Jesus had risen from the dead. This day, is a day that Jesus showed Himself as having victory over sin and death. When the ladies went to the tomb and found it empty, this is what happened: Luke 24:5 In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? 6 He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 7 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'" 8 Then they remembered his words.

Not only had Jesus risen from the dead, but He also fulfilled His words that He WOULD BE raised again after 3 days. Not only was this a surprise, but a miracle and a fulfillment of prophecy too. Jesus' resurrection showed that He was victorious over death and sin. That neither death nor sin could defeat Him. In fact, Paul wrote this concerning death and sin, based upon Jesus' resurrection: 1 Cor. 15:3 ... Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures And later on in this chapter, after talking about the resurrection Paul writes this: 1 Cor 15:54b ... Death has been swallowed up in victory. 55 "Where, O death, is your victory?

Where, O death, is your sting?" 56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

I share these verses because as much as we can and should celebrate Jesus' resurrection - and not just on Easter Sunday, but every day, we should also realize that Jesus' victory over sin and death is also OUR victory too. For if we make the decision to believe in Jesus, and follow Him, we too can have the same victory over sin and death. But ONLY if we trust and rely on Jesus. Our victory comes ONLY through Jesus.

I share about the resurrection because I hope all of us have realized that as a follower of Jesus, we have a victorious life to live. Satan cannot defeat us. BUT, it does require us to trust in Jesus. I hope that you, even though Easter is passed, you will continue to live in the victory that you celebrated during Easter Sunday, because that victory was not only for Jesus, but also for you too.
